

Hacky Sac

Don't follow those hacky tutorials, make this hacky sack instead with Get Arty presenter, Jye!

Level - Medium

What you'll need:

- Fabric (2 different colours or patterns)
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Uncooked rice
- Sewing machine or needle and thread
- Needle and thread

Step 1: With your ruler and maker, rule out a square 13cm x 13cm. Cut a square from each fabric.

Step 2: Place the two squares right side of the fabric together.

Tip: The right side of the fabric is the side which has the bolder print on it. The wrong side will be a slightly faded print.

Step 3: Sew all around the square apart from the top edge. Don't forget to backstitch at the start and the end, this to keep it secure.

Tip: You can pin around the squares if you want so that they stay place while sewing.

Step 4: Turn the fabric the right side out. You will be left with something that looks like a mini bag. Fill the bag with 1 cup of rice.

Step 5: Pinch the top of the fabric so the corners of the fabric are touching in the middle. Fold fabric into the bag by half a centimetre to avoid edges fraying.

Step 6: Sew along the top with a zig zag stitch so the rice is completely enclosed.
